MOSQUITO MEANDER COURSE NARRATIVE

- The course is 5 Kilometers (3.1 miles in length). There are signs at 1, 2, and 3-mile marks.
- There is a water and first aid station at the halfway point along 3rd Avenue
- The course will end in the front parking lot of the Carlson Center.

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- Race will start at the front parking lot at the Carlson Center, the runners will leave the parking lot into the bike path along 2nd Ave. to Hilton Avenue and proceed along Hilton Avenue to Kellum Street

Intersections are: Moore Street, Conrad Street, Wilbur Street, Stewart Street, and Lathrop Street.

- The race will continue along Kellum Street all the way to 4th Avenue

Intersections are: Pedro Street, Gilmore Street, McGown Street, 10th, 9th, 8th, 7th, 6th and 5th Avenues.

- There will be a left turn on 4th Avenue

Intersections are: Bonnifield Street, Cleary Street, State Street, and Badger Street.

- Right turn on Lincoln Street followed by a left turn on 3rd Avenue
- Right turn on Grant Street
- On Grant Street cross 2nd and 1st Avenue, over to the bike path
- The race will proceed on the bike path west going behind the Carlson Center.
- Left turn from the bike path into the front parking lot.

- Race will end in the front parking lot at the Carlson Center



There will be volunteer flaggers at every intersection to help with traffic and point out turns. Traffic Controllers will be wearing bibs with reflectors on them and there will be one or two traffic controllers at consistent

intervals.
